

How to find ?

From the South of the City:

Travelling east along the south quays with the river Liffey on your left, continue on pass City Quay. You are on Sir John Rogerson's Quay when you see The Ferryman Pub, on your right hand side.

Pass the Dublin Docklands Development Authority office and another large glass building. Next to it is a warehouse with two large double doors.

Take the next right turn (*presently the end of the accessible south quays, on the corner of a building site for the new U2 Tower*)

You are on Benson Street. Our office is in the Fitzwilliam Business Centre building on Benson Street. You will see a glass revolving door which leads to our reception. (If you are driving, parking is available under the building which you can access from the rear.)

From the North Quays :

Pass Heuston Station across the river and turning right, travel east along the north quays, past the Four Courts, Ormond Hotel, O'Connell Street (*pass a large monument of O'Connell*) heading toward the International Financial Services Centre. Continue through the next set of traffic lights and on your left is the Custom House (large Georgian Building) with the river on your right.

Keep in the right driving lane, veering to the right lane and as you are crossing the bridge, keep to the left hand side crossing the bridge and turn left after crossing the bridge. You are now on City Quay

Continue straight ahead for a half a mile keeping the water on your left. You are on Sir John Rogerson's Quay, when you will pass The Ferryman Pub, on your right hand side.

From the Airport:

Buses regularly leave the airport heading to both Heuston and Connolly Stations. Get off at Connolly and follow the Directions below.

(Driving from the Airport) – On a quiet day the city centre is at least 30-45 mins. From the airport, follow signs for the city centre and you will enter the city via North Strand Road and Amiens Street. With the International Financial Services Centre on your left, cross the river and turn left you are now on City Quay
